Mid-year Exhibition: June 27-29

Dear Artists,

Our exhibition at the Pumphouse is quickly approaching. I know all of you are excited about being part of this opportunity to show your work to your friends, neighbours, and the community.

Submission Limit

Artists are invited to submit **up to four pieces** of artwork before or on June 8th.

Artwork Size

Artwork width cannot exceed 24 inches to fit on the racks.

Submission Format

Please send your submissions to rhonda@rhondawhittington.com using the following format:

- o Title
- o Name of Artist
- o Medium
- o Price
- o Dimensions of finished work (including frame if applicable)
- o Phone number where you can be contacted (this number will not be made public)

Here is are a few examples:

Volunteers

To make this exhibition a success I will be contacting you at a later date with a list of volunteer opportunities.

Drop off and Pick up

Please drop your paintings off between 4:00 and 4:30 on June 27th and pick them up at 4:00 on June 29th. Please note those times on your calendar. We cannot accept work at other times, and we insist that you pick-up your work at the scheduled time.

Gallery Ready Paintings

Securely affix a label onto the back of each painting with the: Title, Name of the Artist, Medium, Price

We want our exhibits of your artwork to look professional, and we need to be able to install your work easily. Please ensure that you have a strong-enough braided picture hanging wire securely attached to the back of the work. The wire should have enough slack that it is easy for us to use a hand behind the work to guide it onto the rack.

However, the top of the wire when pulled up should be at least 4 cm or 1.5 inches from the top of the frame so that the hanging hardware is not visible when your work is on the wall.

Fees

To help with overhead costs each participant is asked to pay \$35 cash when you bring your paintings for submission on June 27th.

Insurance

Lakeshore Pumphouse Artists Association or the executive is not responsible for litigation theft, or damages to your painting. Each exhibitor is responsible for insuring their own work.

We advise that you only submit original work. People have various definitions of original work. Some define original work as work you painted from life, while others define it as paintings painted from your own photo, paintings painted from someone else's photo, a painting done at a workshop, or a copy of another artist. When deciding what painting(s) you would like to submit please determine your personal definition of "original," based on the risk that you are willing to take in terms of possible litigation from photographers, workshop leaders, or other artists.

I hope I have remembered everything. If you have any questions don't hesitate to contact me.

We have over seventy-five amazing artists in our group. It will be exciting to see examples of all of our work in one location. Grimsby here we come!
