This workshop will be held at St. John's Anglican Church parish hall, in Jordan.

Exit the QEW at Jordan and follow Jordan Road (Reg Rd 26) to King St (Hwy 8, aka Reg Rd 81). Turn right. A short drive along King to McKenzie Dr on the left. On McKenzie, drive through the cemetery on the right to the church. It is in the Hearth Room.

The workshop will be focused on the wonderful ancient cedars that live on the escarpment close to our homes.

The one-day course will incorporate a talk on how one can achieve some wonderful values and hues using a combination that one might normally consider.

Reference photos of these majestic trees are attached. They show the tenuous existence of these trees on the edges of the crags and bluffs, with very little soil to grow in.

I enjoy working with vibrant colours and unexpected colours and hope to inspire you to experiment a bit.

Supplies

Acrylic paints and/or oils; watercolours

Canvas size of your choosing (minimum size 11x14); watercolour paper of equivalent size.

Brushes: Bring a variety of brushes

Palette:

- Red Blue and Yellow primaries at the least
- Black and White
- You are welcome to bring all your acrylics (and watercolours) if you wish.

I will have extra palette paper and acrylic paints if needed.
